Until then, keep the faith and keep on singing!



BLACK HISTORY MONTH: DID YOU KNOW?



Carter G. Woodson was an incredible man who was most notably known as the "father of black history". In February 1926 he founded "Negro History Week", the precursor celebration that inspired what we now call Black History Month!

Born in Virginia as the son of former slaves, Woodson graduated from Kentucky's own Berea College and became a teacher and school

administrator. In 1912 he obtained a PhD from Harvard and remains the only person to obtain a PhD whose parents were slaves!

Woodson announced the second week of February to be "Negro History Week". It was his hope that at least one week of celebration for the recognition and importance of black lives

would allow for the general movement to become an annual celebration.

His week of celebration grew to a full month in February 1969 and became the event we are all familiar with today!

In honor of Carter G. Woodson, let's all remember, recognize, and learn about the black history of America as we celebrate.
