

## WAKON' DA-HO: COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM

With the severity of the COVID situation easing, it has been decided that the Wakon' Da-Ho Counselor in Training (CIT) program should be re-established.

You must be age 16 by March 1st to be eligible to be a CIT. The deadline to apply to the program is April 22nd.

## WAKON' DA-HO: ADDITIONAL UPDATES

The below was sent out from the Christian Church in Kentucky:

"The Wakon' Da-Ho Site Team, in consultation with several camp directors and counselors, have determined that the following procedural changes are appropriate due to the easing severity of the COVID 19 pandemic.

1. We will increase our camp capacity to 8 campers per cabin.
2. We will allow campers to

register for both weeks of CYF camp. Campers must indicate which camp is their first choice in the event one of the camps reaches capacity. We will not allow a camper to be turned away because another camper is attending both weeks. Priority will be given in the order applications are received at the regional office. We cannot honor verbal requests to reserve a spot at camp.

3. We will re-establish the Counselor-in-Training (CIT)

program. Applications can be downloaded from the region's website.

4. Masks are optional. Disparaging comments, ridicule or bullying directed at those who opt to mask will not be tolerated.

We ask that everyone understand that these protocols are subject to change based on CDC directives and the status of the COVID pandemic."
