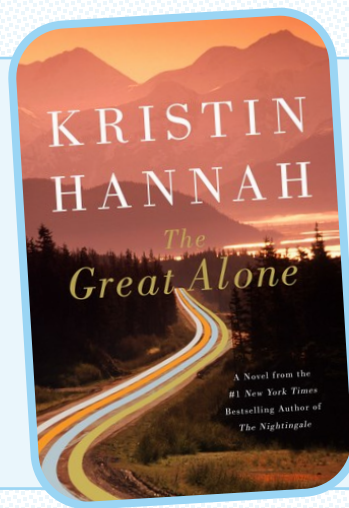

FCC BOOK CLUB

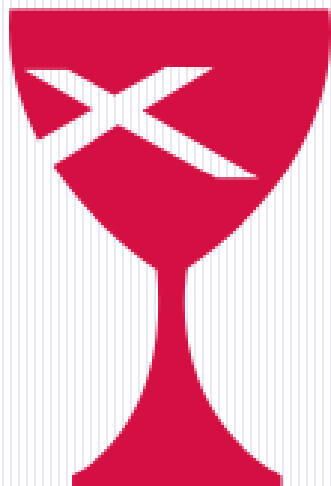
We would like to thank all who participated in last week's discussion and special thanks to Elinor Rambo for leading the discussion!
