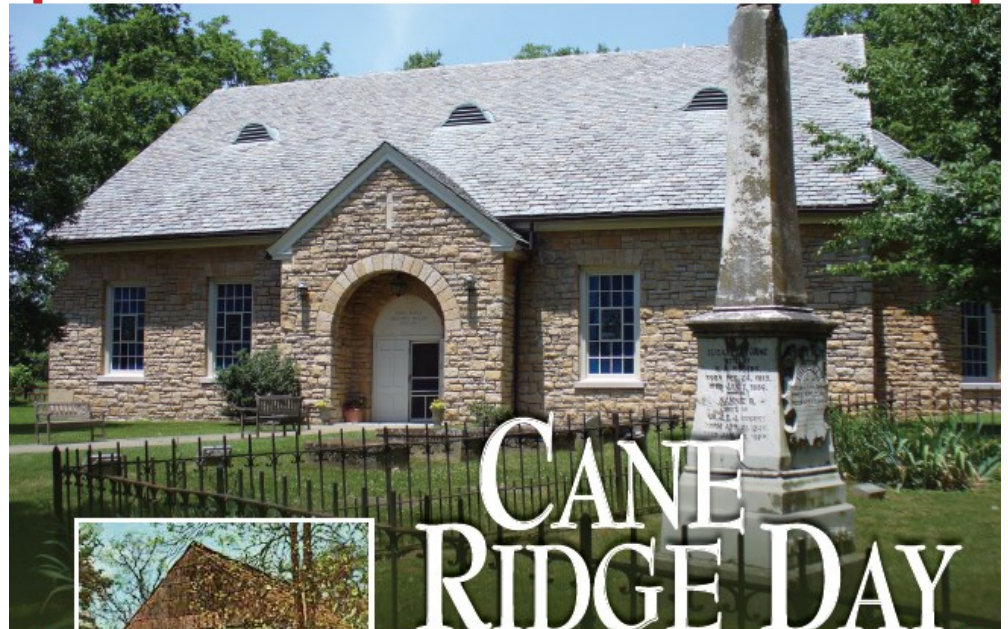

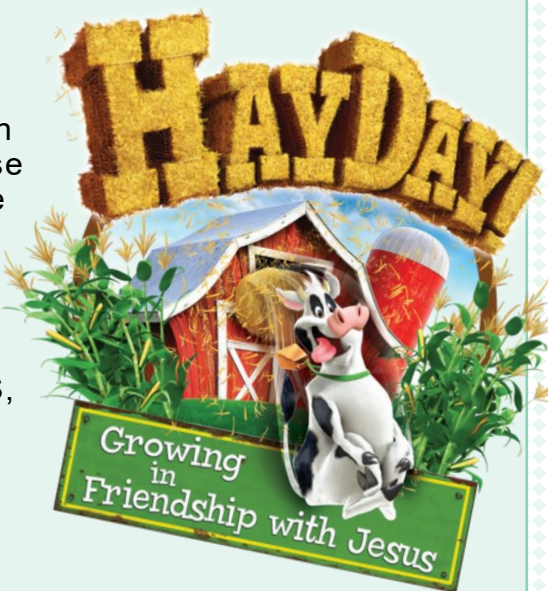

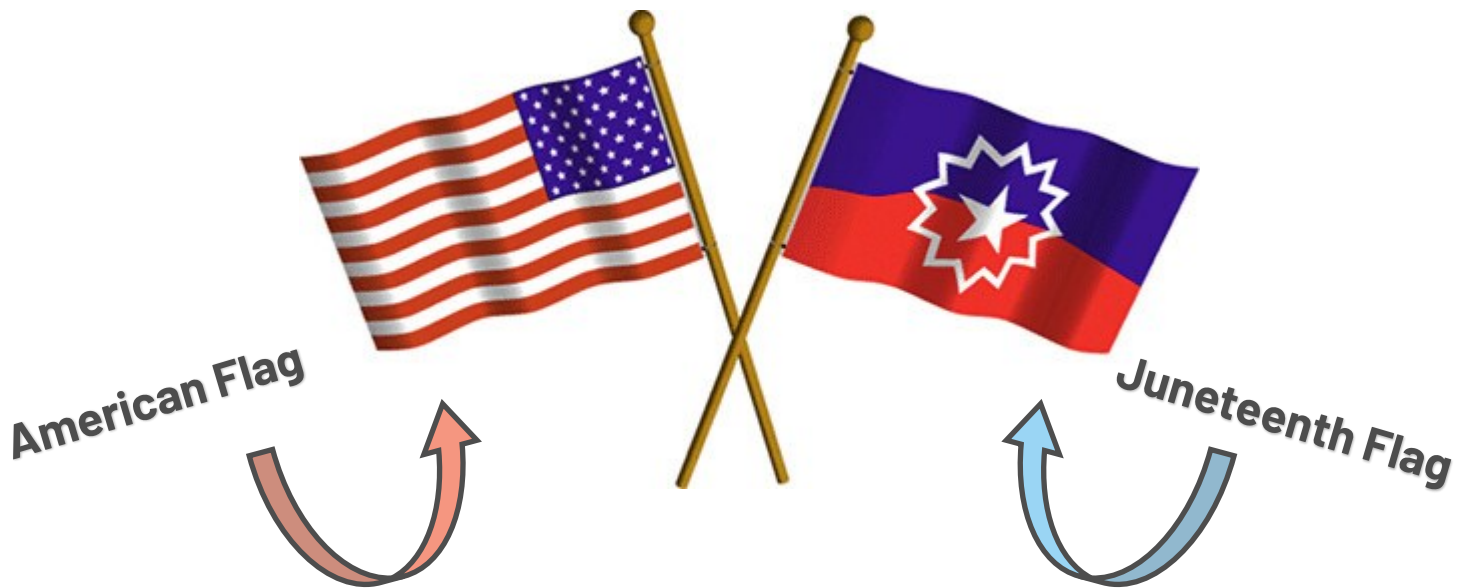

JUNETEENTH GOINGS-ON

Dear Church,

This weekend is Juneteenth - a celebration of when enslaved, Black Americans first learned of their freedom in Galveston, Texas on June 19th 1865. This day has also been called Freedom Day, Jubilee Day, and Black Independence Day. While the celebration is rooted in the Black American consciousness, its call to action is for all of us. A call to work for justice for all, to remember our history, and to celebrate the journey and achievement of our Black neighbors and siblings.

Many of us have been looking for a way to turn our frustration and sense of lack of movement of issues of injustice into action and community. Our congregation has supported the Poor People's Campaign for several years, and this weekend there is a march in DC to align with the national Juneteenth celebration.

For those of us who can't go, I've included links to find out how to reach your state and federal legislators. Now is always a good time to let them know your thoughts on the issues our communities face.

Finally, **this Saturday** there are Juneteenth celebrations in Covington at **Randolph Park** from 11 to 5, and at **First Baptist Church of Elsmere** from 11 to 5.

Thank you to everyone who participated in last month's discussion!

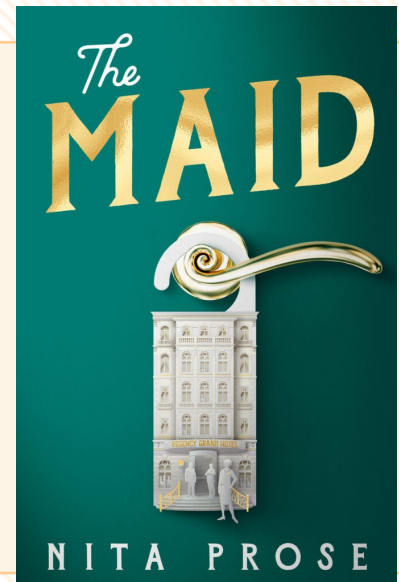
The FCC Book Club has decided that after reading a rather depressing saga last month, a "beach read" is in order!
