Last Meeting Follow-up

Open and Affirming (Tracy)

Last month we approved the creation of the Open and Affirming Committee to begin prayerfully considering if this is the right option for our congregation.

First meeting will be next Monday, July 25th at 6:00 pm.

Church Admin (Tracy)

A job listing has been posted.

Alex says she will be applying but is willing to help train someone new if there is a better fit.

Tracy has 3 candidates currently, and is planning to interview 2 of them. Interviews will take place next week.

BLINK (Alex)

The city sent out a communication stating the festival's map isn't ready to be released; however, the Executive Director, Justin Brookhart, said they plan to expand the reach of BLINK in Covington - from Roebling Point to MainStrasse Village. One of their goals is to creatively highlight historical buildings, architecture, and murals.

What is our goal with BLINK? Should we contact the Exec. Dir. regarding our desire to participate?

Tracy would like for us to contact them to see if they can include the church in their installation. Depending on how BLINK plans to use the church, we may need to advise the recovery groups that meet in the evenings on the weekend.

Advertise with our banners. Maybe have some tables set up that allow people to interact with us, maybe distributing drinks. Maybe show silhouettes to represent the

number of people we serve per week.

Dates include Oct. 13-16.

Arnold House (Tracy)

Tracy reached out to Steve Rehfuss re: the repair of the back wall. Steve said he would be able to do it but it would be a while before he could get to it.

Steve attempted the repair but wasn't able to because the repair is more than anticipated. He will return with the materials needed and repair within the next week or two.

Attic window replacement has been ordered and Home Depot will install it.

Plan is to buy a window from Home Depot and have it installed through them.

Scott suggested using glass block instead of getting the window replaced.

The downspout behind the little library came apart. Cincy Gutter Boys came out last week and gave us a quote to repair the downspout. They are 10-13 weeks out for repairs.

Financial Secretary & Treasurer (Tracy)

It was discussed with Sheri, Tracy, and Alex that it may make more sense to allow the admin to be in the treasurer position (paying bills as they come in, with approval from Tracy first).

Scott brought up the auditing standpoint: the person paying the bills shouldn't be the one ordering things. We need someone else in the mix, for the optics.

Tracy, Scott, Ann, Sheri, and Alex will meet to work out a financial plan for how to make this work.

Sheri is willing to continue making the bill payments until we work out a new solution for the church.

New Business

The wedding arch looks like a "gallows". Tracy says it is coming down this week.

The church members have noticed what a good job Alexsis, "Lex", is doing and would like to meet her. Tracy will see if she would like to come to the picnic or to a LC meeting to meet folks.

The glass door handle is loose. We need a special wrench to tighten it. Tracy and Richard will meet this week to see if they can fix it with the tools Tracy owns.

The double doors by the alley were slightly ajar this morning. Richard was able to pull them closed completely and verified there was no one else in the building before leaving.

The chapel lights have been turned off recently. The sign to leave the lights on has gone missing. Alex will create new signs and put them up to remind folks to keep the lights on.
