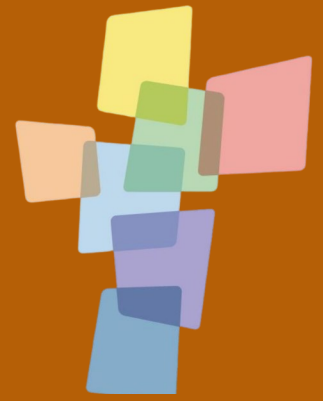
Question received about the Leadership Council and teams: When ministry teams are created, will the leadership council cease to exist, or will the council members, who are supposed to be point people for worship, outreach, property, etc be on the teams? Is there a plan for when council members will begin being the point people?

Answer: The Leadership Council will be working to become point people for various ministries like worship, outreach, property, etc. and do more visioning work at meetings. When new members join the Council in January, it will be the ideal time to choose what areas of ministries they wish to be point person on.

The Leadership Council was never meant to be primarily responsible for ministry but to be point people. The Leadership Council was meant to consider ministry proposals against our mission statement, bless the ministry and offer resources. However, there has not yet been many ministry proposals to the Leadership Council.

The congregation may need the structure of teams to brainstorm, plan and propose ministries. The ministry teams (Team Welcome, Team Love, Team Grace) will gather to determine how they want to live out the mission of welcome, love or grace. The teams can feed ideas to the Leadership Council so that the Leadership Council can celebrate the team work and provide resources as requested. Leadership Council members can serve on the teams, but will not necessarily be the "leader" of those teams.

The Leadership Council members on a team or any team member can share about the progress of ministries to or request additional resources from the Leadership Council. The teams will not become committee-like taking on the responsibilities for worship, outreach or property. Any team's ideas may include outreach projects or worship ideas or property projects if that team feels it will promote their designated mission of welcome, love or grace.

The Witness Tree

A Press Release from the City of Florence, KY

The City of Florence, in partnership with Florence Christian Church, will be hosting “The Witness Tree” Event. The event will be held beginning November 1st, 2022 and run through November 11th, 2022 daily at 8:00 AM on the campus of the Florence Government Center at the Boone County Veteran’s Memorial. The program is anticipated to last approximately fifteen minutes each day.

The Witness Tree program is designed to raise awareness of those invisible wounds that veterans are battling after they return to civilian life and raise awareness of the estimated 22 veterans who commit suicide each day in our nation. The daily ceremony will include placing 22 dog tags on a tree, readings, meditative thought, and reflection. At the end of the eleven days, 222 dog tags will hang in honor of those veterans. Visitors are invited to attend and hang military dog tags on the designated tree on the campus of the Florence Government Center.
