From the Desk of Paul Jackson

First Christian Covington congregation,

As communicated earlier, the Leadership Council has been discussing the future of our church for several months. During our April 9 Leadership Council call, we formally voted to recommend to the congregation to immediately sell the church building. The financial burden has become too great given our low attendance and thus low offerings.

On May 11 the congregation unanimously voted to approve the Leadership Council recommendation to sell our church building.

Important points:

1. Selling the building is not the same as closing our church
2. Until the building sells (which could take months or even years) we will continue to meet and worship in our beautiful building.
3. We will use the third Sunday monthly luncheons (starting in June) to begin discussions about what to do as a church once the building is sold and is thus no longer available for us to use for worship.
4. The "building" is not the church; our people are the church.

Again, we will continue to meet and worship in our building for the foreseeable future as we continue to live into our mission to **welcome wholly, love authentically and share God's grace abundantly.**

We hope to see you in worship this coming and for many future Sundays.
