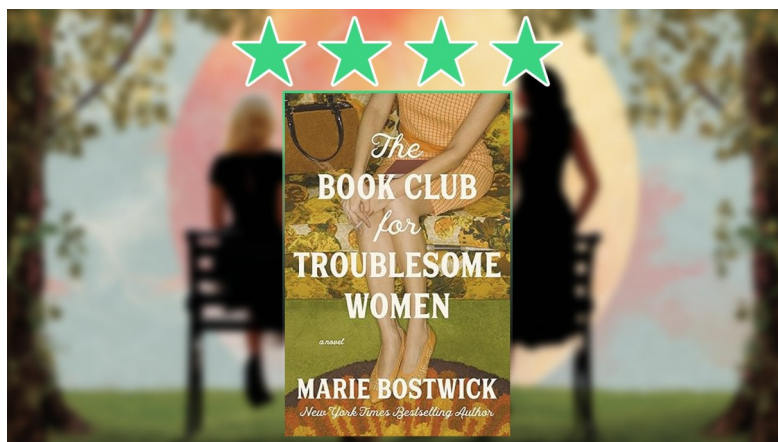
Upcoming Events

April Book Club Details

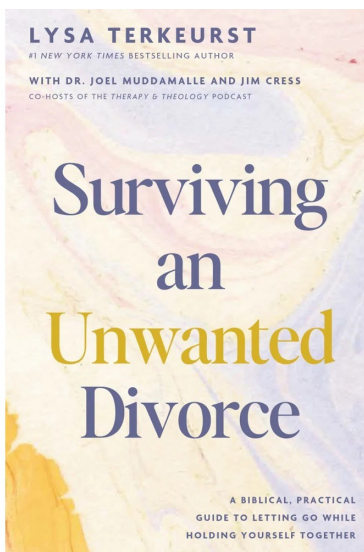
